The **Policy for Environment, Health and Safety** is the key-concept of the general **Corporate Strategy** according to the Integrated Management System. This concept clearly turns out from the Ethical Code recently implemented by GF-ELTI.

Priority

- to guarantee the respect of what it is stated by the applicable Norms in terms of Quality (ISO 9001), Environment (ISO14001), Occupational Health and Safety (OHSAS 18001) as well as the obligations of conformity including those applicable to products and services;
- to pursue the constant improvement of integrated system effectiveness, so as to able to ensure the amelioration of products and services offered, to empower customer satisfaction along with the performances in terms of environmental footprint, working conditions and occupational health and safety;
- to secure the prevention of accidents and events that may be cause of environmental pollution and / or casualties and / or occupational diseases for co-workers;
- to ensure the constant communication and collaboration among all the interested parties either within or outside the Organization.

Principles

- to evaluate risks and opportunities in order to ameliorate performances in terms of Quality, Environment, and Occupational Health and Safety;
- to evaluate the context as well as customers' and other parties' future needs;
- to seek activity, products and services sustainability;
- to adopt and promote principles of prevention in order to diminish Environment, Occupational Health and Safety dangers and risks;
- to encourage staff involvement in the pursue of Corporate objectives, through the creation of a motivating and challenging working environment;
- to have a process-based approach and careful management of business relations;
- to have a continuous improvement approach as basic principle for every activity or process;
- to have mutual beneficial relation with suppliers, with dedication to the development of continuative business relations (partnership).

Every employee within the Organization is invited to actively participate in the implementation process of the Principles stated above with commitment, attention and determination. It is our belief that by applying these principles there will be the best satisfactory working conditions.
